What do I do if my child is sick?

Please call the student absence line at 403-748-3770 or by email to bentley@wolfcreek.ab.ca to report your child sick or absent. Anyone sick with symptoms of COVID-19 or any respiratory virus MUST STAY HOME until they are well. Please monitor your children each day using the Alberta Health Daily Checklist. Parents should remain up to date on current isolation and quarantine requirements at:

www.alberta.ca/isolation.aspx. Students who have to miss class due to illness will be supported by their teacher, as in pre-pandemic school years. Parents/ caregivers will be contacted to pick up students who develop symptoms while at school.

As you are aware, September 30th has been proclaimed by the Government of Canada as the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation. This day is meant to recognize and reflect on the survivors of, and the families and communities still impacted by the legacy of residential schools. Marking that history and sharing and learning is key as we move forward, step by step, on the road of reconciliation. This means there will be no classes and schools will be closed for the day. Bentley School will mark the occasion with students and staff by honoring Orange Shirt Day on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>September 28</u>, and through conversation and learning around the history and legacy of residential schools

Volunteers & User Groups

Bentley School has decided not to allow user groups or volunteers into the facility at this time. This will be reviewed again in the near future. Masks are mandatory for any visitors entering the school. All visitors must check in at the office.

Chromebooks

It is strongly recommended that Gr. 9 - 12 students bring a chromebook, laptop or another form of technology to complete daily coursework. Chromebook availability will be very limited. Students in other grades who have chromebooks are encouraged to bring them as well.

All student progress will be available through internet based portals for K - 12. FreshGrade is no longer available for the district to use. They are moving to a new program called Schoology. Watch for more information as it becomes available.



Dear Parent or Guardian.

Re: COVID-19 School Immunization Program

Alberta Health Services (AHS), Public Health School Immunization Program is offering a dose of the COVID-19 vaccine to eligible students in Grades 7 to 12, who are born in 2009 or earlier.

Your child can get a dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech mRNA COVID-19 vaccine in school if they:

- have never had a COVID-19 vaccine (this will be their first dose)
- had their first dose of a COVID-19 vaccine at least 3 weeks ago (this will be their second dose)

Your child's school will let you know when the COVID-19 vaccine will be offered at their school.

This package includes a consent form and information for the COVID-19 vaccine.

To have your child immunized at school:

- read this information package
- print the consent form and sign it

The consent form must be completed by a parent or guardian. Your child will not be immunized at school without your consent (permission).

On the consent form:

- Complete your child's personal information.
- Complete your child's health information.
- Sign and date the consent form. Return the form to the school no later than 1 week after school starts.

Call your school's public health nurse if your child:

- has had a severe side effect to an immunization in the past
- has any changes to their health before getting the COVID-19 vaccine
- . gets another vaccine in the 14 days before immunizations will be provided at your school

If you agree to the immunization, your consent means that your child will get **a dose** of the COVID-19 vaccine. If the consent form is not returned, your child will not be immunized at their school.

Care after immunization information will be given to your child after they are immunized. Please review this information with your child.

Only one dose of vaccine will be given in school. If your child needs another dose, COVID-19 immunizations can be booked online at ahs.ca/vaccine or by contacting Health Link at 811.

If you do not wish to have your child immunized:

- · do not sign the consent form
- do not return the consent form

If you agree to the immunization but later change your mind, please call your school's public health nurse to let them know.

If you have any questions or need more information, call your local public health office or 811.
