- Minimum donation **\$20**. You will have a minimum of 2 images to choose from.

Family Portrait Sessions will be held at the school Friday June 8 & Saturday June 9, 2018

-Minimum donation **\$85**. You will have a minimum of 3 images to choose from which will include one family pose, a pose of your children as a group, and parents.

Wardrobe Suggestions

Kinder Grad Portraits:

Have your child wear a white shirt with a collar. This can be a button up white shirt or blouse, or a Golf Tee with a white collar. I will have white button up shirts to put on your child over top of his/her clothes if you are unable to find a suitable options.

The kids will be wearing a Graduation Cap. Girls with long hair could wear their hair down or in "low" pony tails. Please avoid high pony tails as this make it hard to fit the cap. Boys just need to have their hair tidy.

Family Portraits:

Colour Palette- Choose 1-3 colours for your group portrait, ones with similar tones that go nicely together, and have everyone work within that colour palette. For example: dark green, navy and burgundy- all dark jewel tones. OR tan, a lighter olive green, and denims- all lighter, softer tones.

For best results, try to stay away from any bold prints or patterns, as these tend to be distracting to the eye. You want the focus to be on your family not your clothes.

Shoes are preferred over sock feet. Keep jewellery simple.

Please feel free to bring props that are important to your family, such as sports equipment or jerseys, musical instrument, or pets.
