



Blue Mountain Power Co-op Scholarship Program

The Blue Mountain Power Co-op Scholarship Program was established to recognize the academic accomplishments of the children of members, and to assist the students with their post-secondary education pursuits.

Annually, Blue Mountain Power Co-op awards two \$1,000 scholarships to the top applicants. Applicants must be the child or legal ward of a Blue Mountain Power Co-op member who is in good standing at the time of application. Applicants must be planning to enroll in the first year of a post-secondary program that is at least two years in length.

A completed application form is required, along with an essay that outlines the applicant's career goals and two letters of reference. Recipients are chosen based on the average of their five highest Grade 12 courses and their career goals essay. **The application deadline is 4 pm July 15, 2022.**

Blue Mountain Power Co-op MEMBER SCHOLARSHIPS

What is the BLUE MOUNTAIN POWER CO-OP Scholarship? The BLUE MOUNTAIN POWER CO-OP Scholarship was established in 2014 to recognize the academic accomplishments of the children of BLUE MOUNTAIN POWER CO-OP members and to assist and encourage them to continue their education. Each year two \$1,000 scholarships are awarded; one to the top male applicant and one to the top female applicant.

Who can apply? Applicants for this scholarship must be residents of Alberta (based on their parent's address). At least one of their parents (or legal guardian) must be a member in good standing of BLUE MOUNTAIN POWER CO-OP at the time of the application. Applicants must be planning to enroll in the first year of a post-secondary program that is at least two (2) years long.

How are recipients chosen? The recipients will be chosen by a selection committee. Applicants will be judged on their academic success, based on the average of their 5 highest grade 12 courses with a minimum three credit value, and on their career goals essay.

What is needed to apply? A completed application form is required as well as official transcripts, post-secondary institution acceptance letter and a career goals essay. Candidates must also provide two letters of reference from individuals (teachers, employers, religious representative, or coach) describing the qualities that they feel the applicant displays which makes him / her a suitable candidate for this award. Achievements in extracurricular and / or community activities should also be included. The career goals essay must be included on a separate sheet of paper. The essay must outline your study plans and career goals and it must be typed, double spaced and no longer than 1,000 words.

When do the applications need to be submitted? The application deadline is July 15, 2022 for students planning to enroll in a post-secondary program for September of the same year. Applications received after the deadline cannot be considered.

Where do I send the completed applications? Application forms must be mailed to the BLUE MOUNTAIN POWER CO-OP Main Office at: 4920 – 43rd Street, Rocky Mountain House, AB T4T 1B2 or dropped in the drop box at the office.



Scholarship Application Guidelines

This scholarship was established by BLUE MOUNTAIN POWER CO-OP to recognize the academic accomplishments of children of BMPC members and to assist and encourage further education. Two scholarships of \$1,000 each are granted each year to the top applicants.

Eligibility Requirements:

Applicant must:

- be a Canadian citizen (or permanent resident) and a resident of Alberta;
- have at least one parent, or their legal guardian, be a member in good standing of BLUE MOUNTAIN POWER CO-OP at the time of application; and
- be planning to enroll in the first year of a post-secondary program of at least two years in length.

In addition, applicants must include:

- an essay describing their study plans and future career goals. The essay should be typed, double-spaced and no longer than 1,000 words;
- a copy of their post-secondary institution acceptance letter
- official Government of Alberta transcripts (once available); and
- two letters of reference either from teachers, employers, coaches, or religious representative. The letter should describe the qualities the applicant displays which make them an appropriate candidate for this award. For example the letter may include information regarding the applicant's academic standing, achievement in extracurricular activities, and/or community involvement.

Selection procedure:

Recipients will be chosen by a selection committee. Applicants will be judged on their academic success based on the average of their five highest Grade 12 courses with a minimum three credit value, their essay, and letters of reference.

Application procedure:

Application deadline is July 15, 2022.

All applicants will be notified of the results of their application by September 15 annually. BLUE MOUNTAIN POWER CO-OP will arrange to present the awards to the two recipients.
