RURAL SCHOOL BUS STUDENTS

Students who live in the country <u>and</u> are new to rural busing OR have moved to a new rural location are <u>required</u> to register for transportation.

All rural kindergarten students must be registered to ride the bus.

Your full legal land description <u>AND</u> complete blue sign (911 address) are required to register.

*Unsure of which school your child should attend, please call us with your legal land description.

If you have moved you must notify the school of the address change prior to registering for busing. *Cross boundary students must re-apply each year by filling out the regular application and the cross boundary application. Please note that cross boundary fees will apply.

Driver's Training is a Go!

It's not too late to register!

Bentley School is excited to partner with Street Wise Driving School again this year to offer driver's training to our students. Students will receive 15 hours of classroom instruction and 10 hours of driving time. If desired, driving hours can be started before classroom instructions begin.

Transportation of Student Items

With the winter sports season upon us, parents are reminded that certain items are not allowed to be transported on school buses as per <u>Administrative</u> <u>Procedure 562</u>. This policy covers all large items and specifically outlines some items but is not a comprehensive list. For example, skates must have guards on them and they must be in a backpack or sports bag (not a plastic grocery bag). No hockey or lacrosse sticks, no curling brooms, no large school projects, etc. will be permitted. This AP is inline with provincial guidelines and in the matter of safety, bus drivers are instructed to refuse unsafe items on the bus under the guidelines of AP 562.

Oral Health Services for K - 2

School based preventive oral health services will be offered to Kindergarten to Grade 2 students February 1 & 2 to those students who returned signed consent forms.

Dental Outreach of Red Deer Program

Location: Red Deer Johnstone Crossing Community Health Centre

Free urgent dental care service is available for clients ages 5 - 18 years who have: no dental insurance, lower income or trouble paying; and, who have pain, infection, visible decay or broken teeth.

Services offered are income eligible and include:

- free dental treatment services (ie. x-rays, fillings, extractions)
- free prevention services (ie. sealants, fluoride, cleanings)
- free education to reduce risk of cavities
