- One big piece of advice from our SRO, is that once your kids go online there is no pulling it back. It is also important to connect with your kids on all social media platforms to monitor your child's online behaviour.

 Dave also noted that kids should not need to be in their rooms with the door closed while they are online; at the kitchen table or in another common area of the house is highly recommended.

5. Administrative Updates:

Covid-19 Updates

- Alberta Education has said that masks for K-3 students are now "strongly recommended," but not required
- If you test positive for Covid-19 and are fully vaccinated, you may return to school after 5 days of isolation (but you must wear a mask for an addition 5 days in all public spaces)
- Field trips and extracurricular activities can continue, but at one-third capacity
- No extracurricular tournament play at this time, but games and practices can continue
- It is strongly recommended to avoid field trips at this time (Bentley School is continuing to offer virtual field trips only)
- One rapid test kit per student will be available: to claim your kit, please add it to your cart in PowerSchool (there is no fee for this)
