Planning to volunteer this year?

The volunteer application process has been updated to reflect current Wolf Creek policy. All volunteers are required to complete a <u>Volunteer Application Form</u> (must be completed yearly) and a <u>Criminal Record Declaration Form</u> (valid for 3 years). The <u>Vulnerable Sector Check Application</u> is valid for 3 years and is <u>only required</u> if the volunteer will be:

- Working Closely with children in situations where he/she will be alone with individual children and groups of children, without direct supervision and oversight from staff; and
- In a natural position of trust and authority given the relationship between children and school volunteers

All prospective volunteers are subject to screening and possible interviews with school administrators. These forms will be kept on file at the school.

Fibre Arts Donations

Next quarter, Jr. High students will have the opportunity to take a Fibre Arts option, and we are looking for supplies! If you have any spare knitting or crocheting supplies, embroidery needles, thread or general hand sewing supplies, we ask that you drop them off at the school.

Hockey Academy Registration is Open

Registration for Hockey Academy is open. Pam Stephenson is leading the program this year and it will begin October 18 and run until the middle of March. The cost is \$150 and includes a practice jersey and one hour of ice time per week. Parents can sign students up through the PowerSchool and online payments parent portal, deadline is 9:00 am on Friday October 7, 2022. Students will be placed into groups and will skate either on Tuesday or Thursday afternoon. All students are required to have full hockey equipment. Bags can be dropped off at the arena between 8 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. the morning of their scheduled skate. Please do not deliver bags to the school. Students will walk back and forth to the arena under the supervision of the lead teacher or an EA. Parents will be notified which day their child will skate once registration has closed.


AHS Oral Health Services

The school oral health program is part of the AHS Oral Health Action Plan (OHAP), with the goal of preventing dental disease in children from selected schools through the provision of fluoride varnish and dental sealants. Fluoride varnish is a topical solution which is painted on teeth and helps to prevent tooth decay. A dental sealant is a thin plastic coating applied to molars and has been shown to significantly reduce tooth decay in children's permanent teeth.

For students with written parental/guardian consent, qualified AHS Oral Health dental hygienists and dental assistants will be on site October 11 and 12 to provide visual dental observation and two fluoride varnishes to Kindergarten to Grade 2 students and dental sealants (where resources permit) to Grade 1 & 2 students.


