

# **Registration for 2024-2025** Open for Pre-K and Kindergarten

New student registration for Pre-K & Kindergarten to Gr. 12 opened January 8. If you currently have a student in Pre-K who is either Kindergarten age or returning to Pre-K, parents will receive an email with returning student registration instructions. Current, Kindergarten to Grade 11 students won't receive returning student instructions until August 2024.

#### Pre-Kindergarten New Student Registration for 2024-2025

- Returning Pre-Kindergarten students will receive an email with registration instructions.
- New students must select the 2024-2025 NEW BFPA Registration Form
- Children must be 3 or 4 years of age by December 31 of the upcoming school year in order to apply
- Programs are designed for children to attend two days per week on a Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday. Four days per week programming may be available following further consultation with families and is based on location and availability.
- A copy of the original birth certificate and other legal documentation (custody orders, etc.) must accompany your registration. If you need to order your child's birth certificate, click on the link to Alberta Services.
- Pre-Kindergarten students are not eligible for busing.

#### Kindergarten New Student Registration for 2024-2025

- Students currently in Bright Futures who are of Kindergarten age will receive an email with registration instructions.
- New students must select the 2024-2025 NEW K-12 Registration Form
- Children must be 5 years of age by December 31 of the upcoming school year in order to apply
- Programs are designed for children to attend two full days per week. Days offered will depend on the number of students registered. Please register by March 31 to help with program planning.
- Kindergarten class placements are based on a number of factors including, number of kindergarten registrations received, date of registration, program day availability and student needs, not just on parent preference.
- A copy of the original birth certificate and other legal documentation (custody orders, etc.) must accompany your registration. If you need to order your child's birth certificate, click on the link to <u>Alberta Health Services</u>.
- Rural Kindergarten students are eligible to apply for busing.

Who needs to register for Bus transportation for the 2024/25 school year?

All urban (in town students - Ponoka, Lacombe, and Blackfalds).

All students new to transportation (ECS or changing schools and are new to busing).

All students who are moving to a new address.

All Cross Boundary students must re-register every year.

#### Who does not need to register?

Rural students who have not had a change in address or school location.

#### **Unsure?**

#### What do you need to do to register?

Street address if urban, Legal land description and complete 911 address if rural.

#### RURAL SCHOOL BUS STUDENTS

Students who live in the country <u>and</u> are new to rural busing OR have moved to a new rural location are <u>required</u> to register for transportation.

#### All rural kindergarten students must be registered to ride the bus.

#### Your full legal land description <u>AND</u> complete blue sign (911 address) are required to register.

\*Unsure of which school your child should attend, please call us with your legal land description. If you have moved you must notify the school of the address change prior to registering for busing. \*Cross boundary students must re-apply each year by filling out the regular application and the cross boundary application. Please note that cross boundary fees will apply.


